Course Description

In this course, students focus on three-dimensional art (i.e. artwork observed in terms of its height, width and depth). Students study art in terms of form (shape, volume and mass) and elements (balance, proportion and rhythm). Focus of study may be on computer-based art (3D models, 3D animations, 3D sculptures) or physical art (pottery and sculpture) and students may explore individual areas of interest.
