The king sent a knight to find and slay the dragon.




One night, the knight rode out to find the dragon.
A flock of crows took flight at the sight of the knight speeding along on his steed.




The knight saw a bright light rise from behind a hill.

He thought the bright light might be from the dragon.




The knight rode up to the light.

I do not want to fight."




The knight felt sad for the dragon's plight. He was a kind knight.
