

D – Noisy Tongue Dancing Sound

“Did you know that *T* has a noisy partner? You’re still going to tap your tongue up there, but this time, put your voice on. What sound does it make? ‘D-d-d-d’ (Tap fingers on the table noisily.) (Show picture.) This is another dancing tongue that’s tapping up there, behind the teeth. It’s our noisy tongue dancing sound. He likes to make a lot of noise when he dances. Do you see his very big tummy? He likes to tap on it like it’s a noisy drum, ‘D-d-d-d!’ See his big, noisy, tap dancing shoes? They remind us that he makes a lot of noise when he dances. Whenever you see that huge tummy that looks like a drum, tap on it like it’s a drum and make the noisy tongue dancing sound, ‘D-d-d-d.’”

Hand cue: Tap loudly on the table as if banging on a drum.
