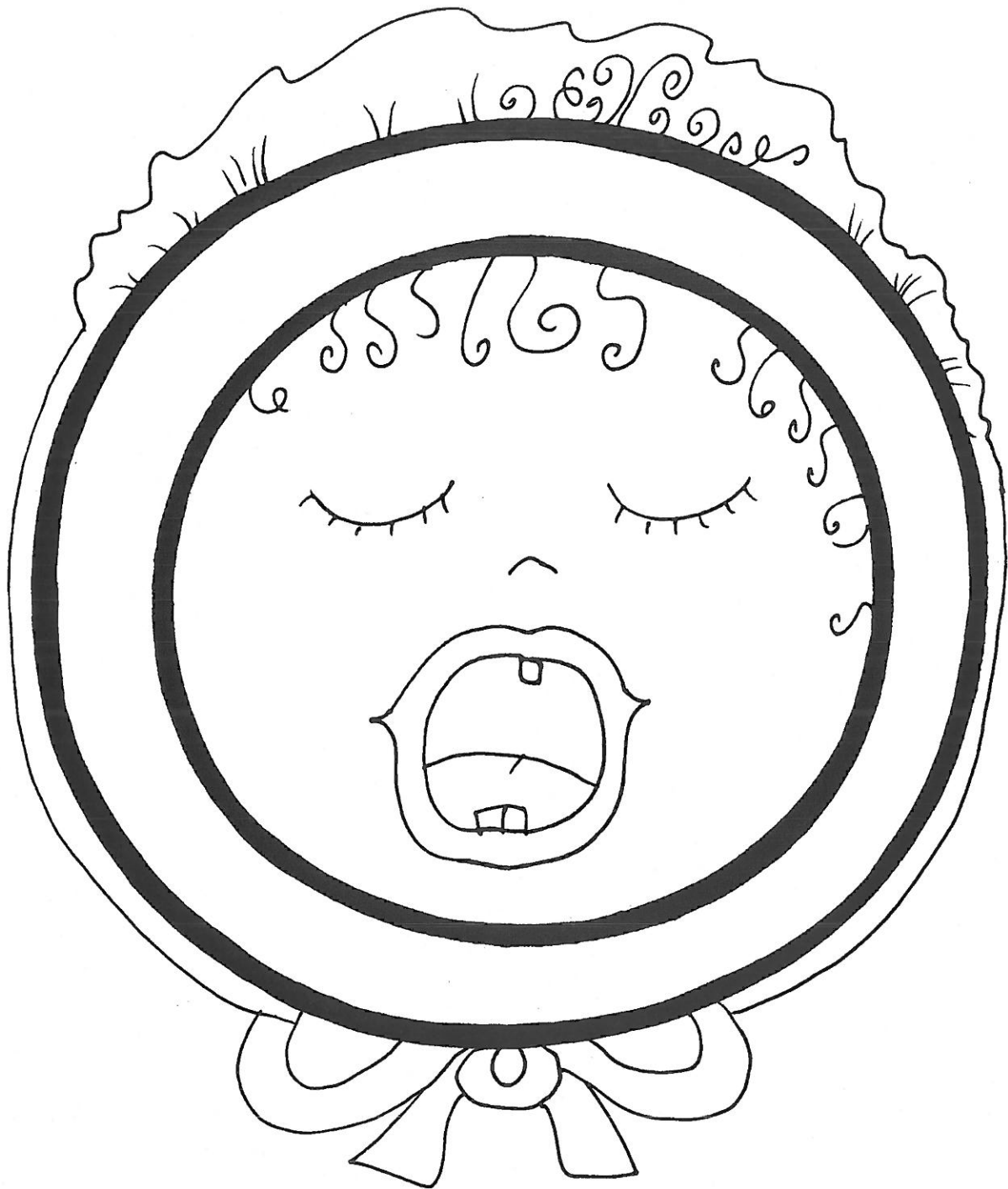

The Baby

Standard Dialect, "ah"

Story – When the mother wants to feed her baby, she holds out a spoonful of cereal as she says, "Open wide."

Hand cue: Pretend to hold out a spoonful of food and open mouth wide.

Northeastern U.S. Dialect, "aw"

Story - What do you say when you see a cute baby? "Aw, isn't she cute!"

Hand cue: Tilt your head to the side and touch your chin or cheek in a gentle fashion.
