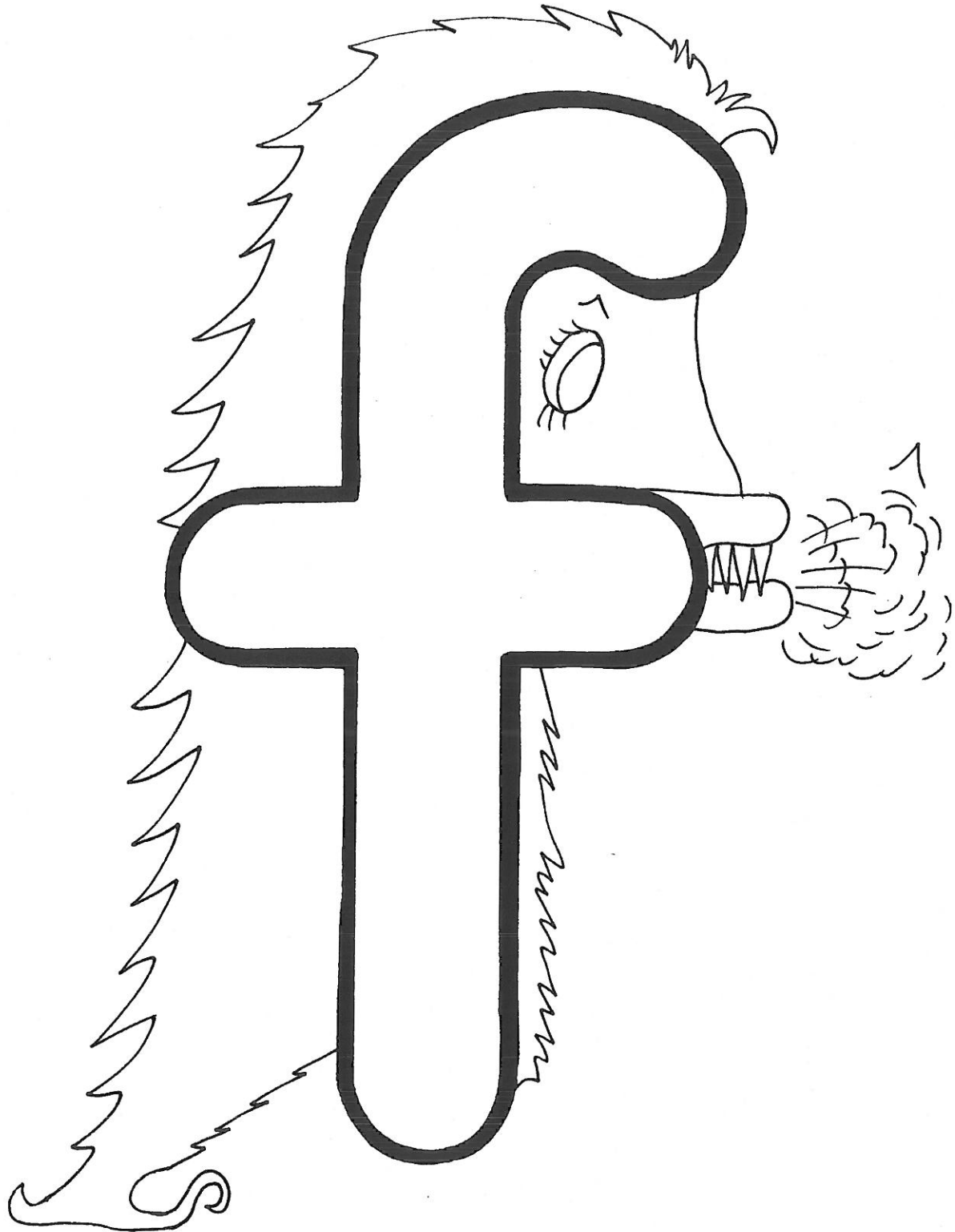

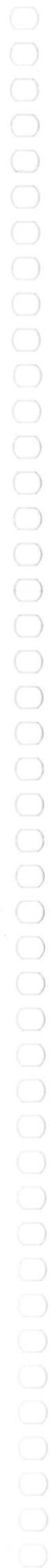
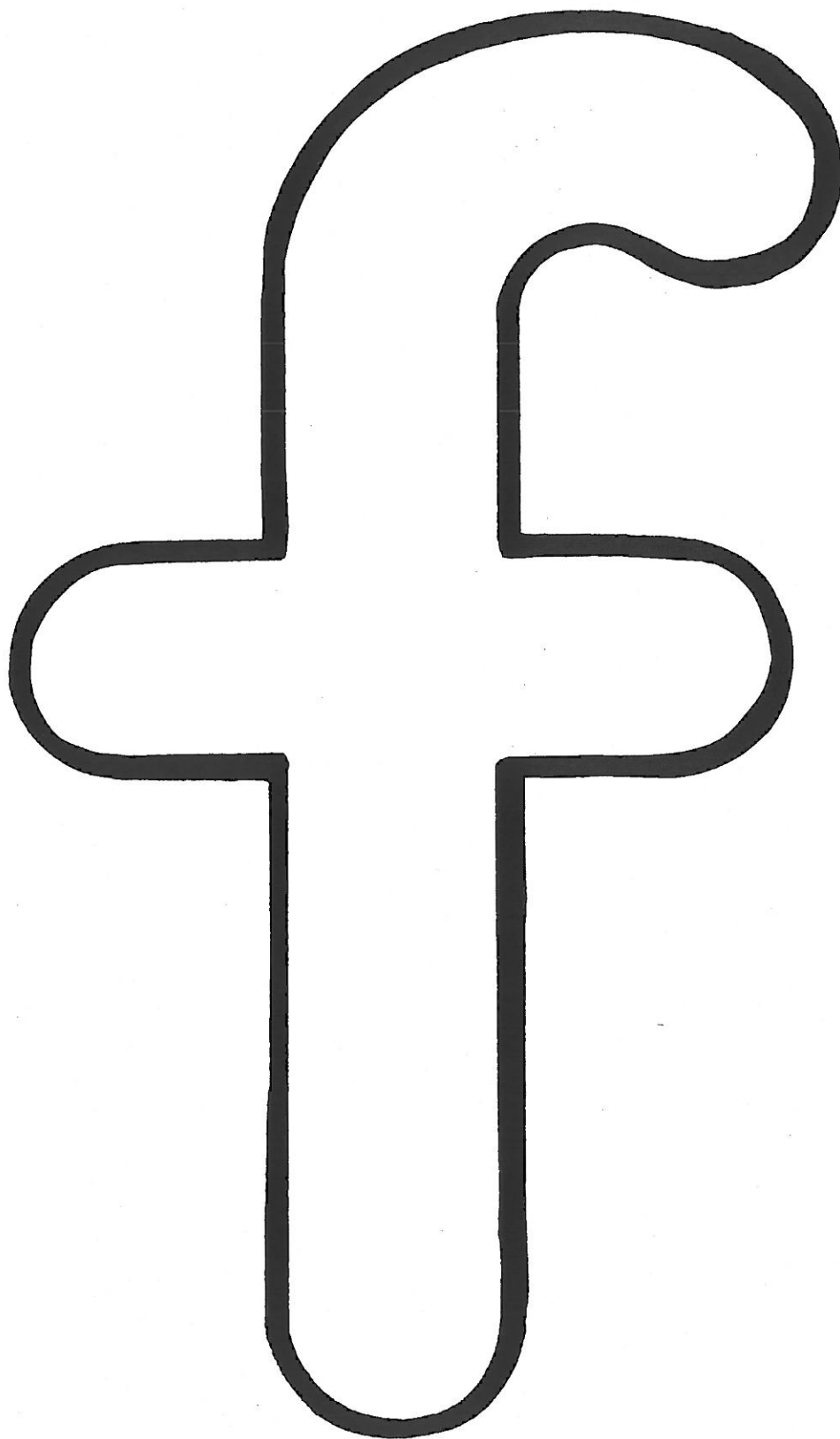


Quiet Lip Biting Sound

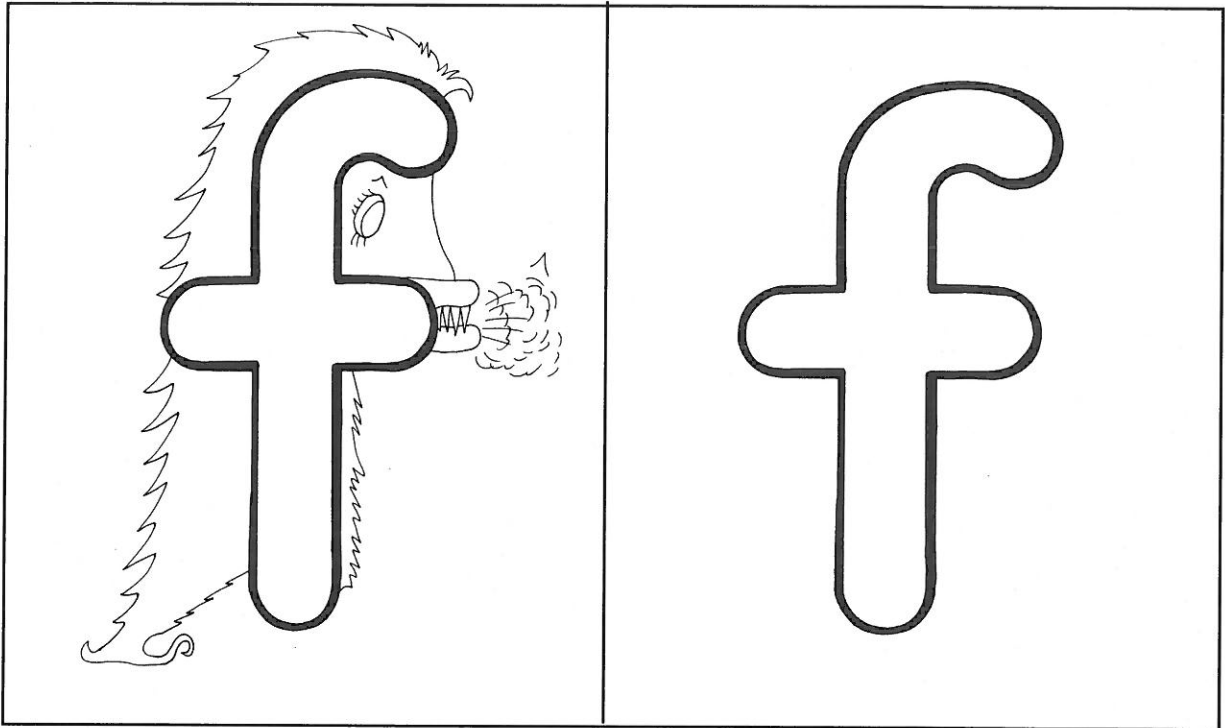
Story - The quiet, fire-breathing dragon bites his bottom lip and blows on it to put out the fire. He sticks out his head because he thinks he looks cool.

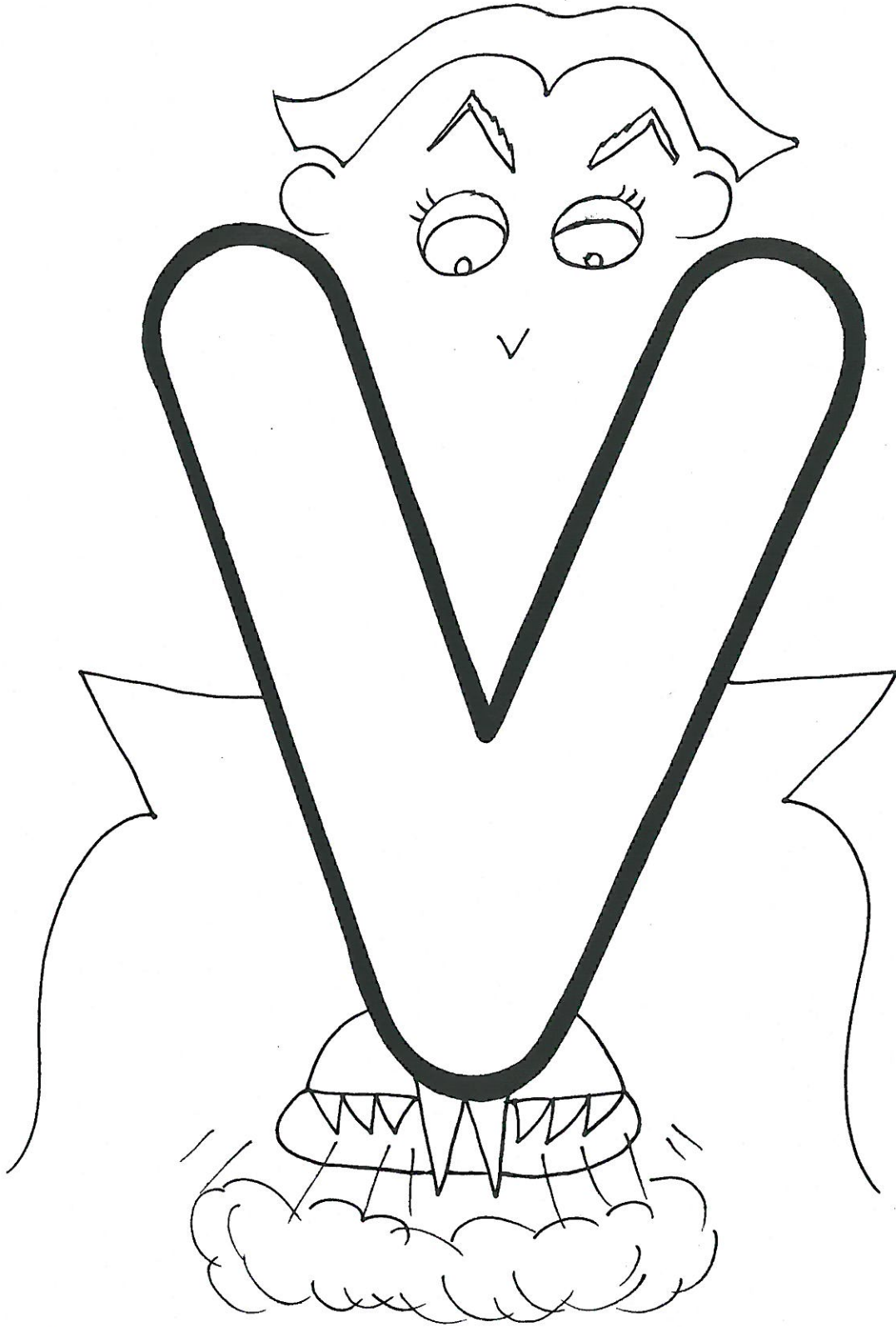

## **F – Quiet Lip Biting Sound**

“When I make this sound, ‘Fffff,’ what am I doing? Right, I’m biting my lip and blowing air on it! Make that sound. Is your voice on or off? Right, it’s off. (Show picture.) There was a quiet, friendly dragon who used to breathe out fire. One day, his bottom lip caught on fire! He bit it like this (bite bottom lip) and blew on it like this (make ‘f’ sound) and the fire went out! Now, he thinks that’s a cool sound, so he walks around school all day, quietly making that lip biting sound. He thinks he looks cooler when he sticks his head out while he makes the sound. Stick your head out and make the sound ‘Fffff.’”

*Hand cue: Put fingers under the bottom lip you’re biting, and stick out your head.*

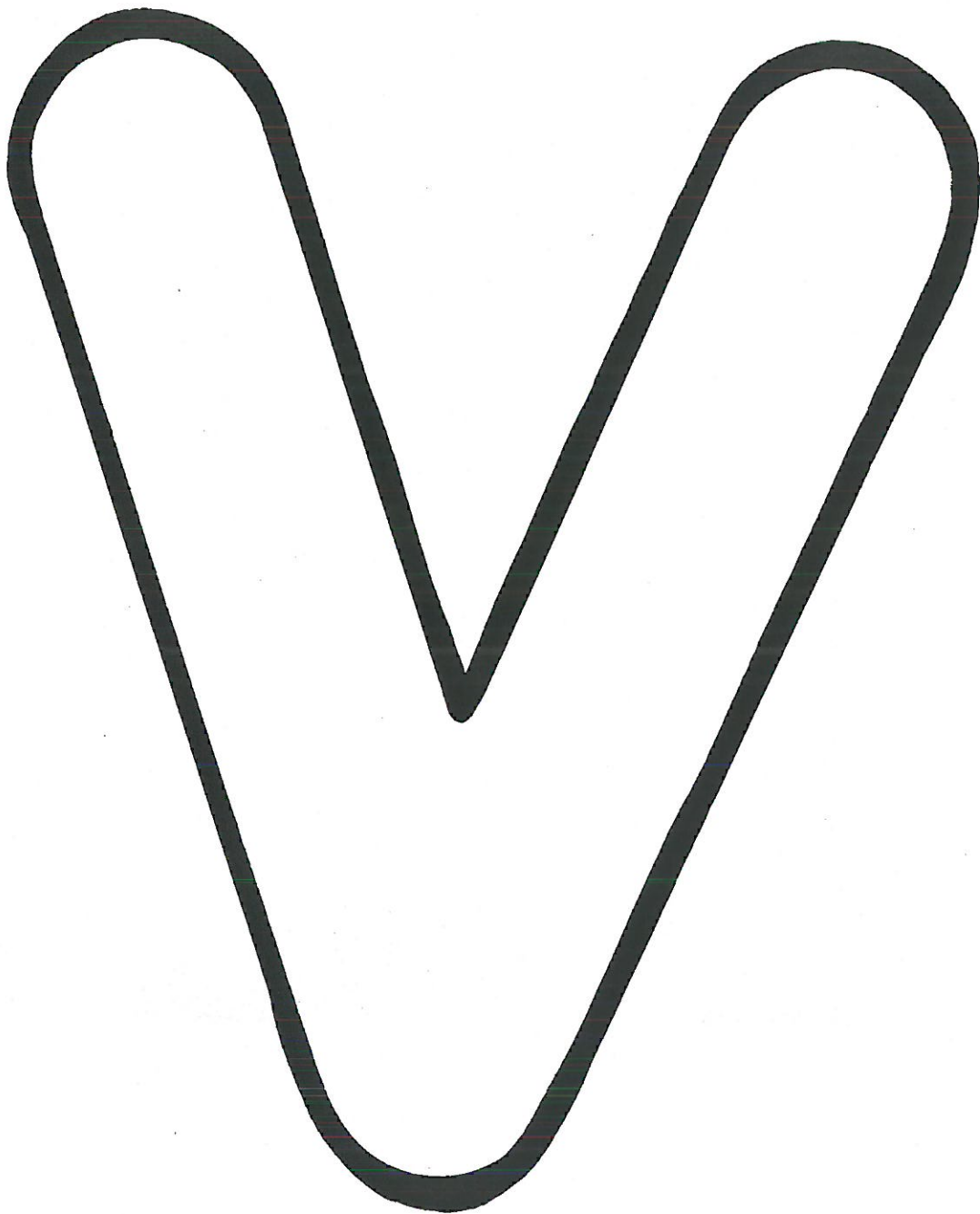
Noisy Lip Biting Sound

Story – The noisy vampire bites his bottom lip and blows. He turns on his voice so he'll scare everyone.

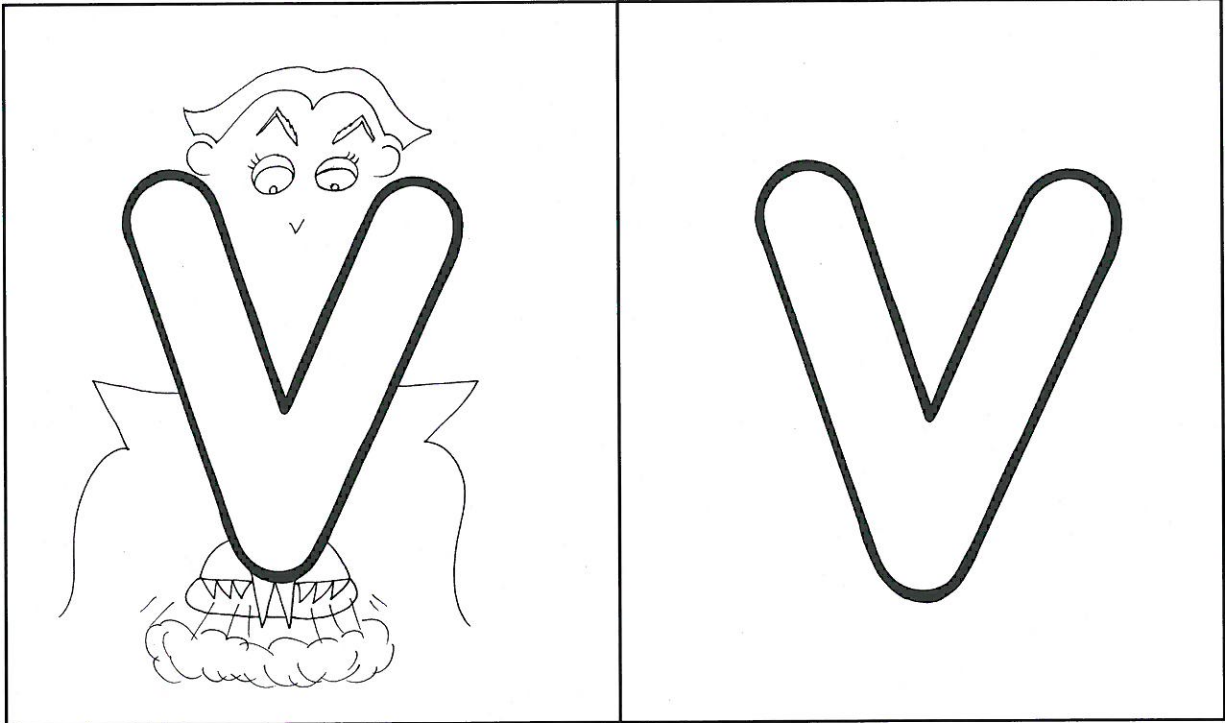
Hand cue: Put fingers under bottom lip; make a scary face.

## V – Noisy Lip Biting Sound

“What would the noisy partner sound be for that quiet lip biting sound, ‘f?’ Bite your bottom lip once more, but this time, turn on your voice. ‘Vvvvv.’ That’s it! That’s the noisy lip biting sound. (Show picture.) This is a noisy vampire who loves to bite his bottom lip and make lots of noise. Even though he is a very friendly vampire, he thinks it’s funny to make believe he’s a scary vampire. He holds his hands up and turns on his voice while he bites his lip. ‘Vvvvv!’ He thinks he’s very scary when he does that, but I’m not scared at all, are you? Let’s act like him and turn on our voices while we bite our lips. (Hold hands up.) ‘Vvvv!’”

*Hand cue: Hold fingers under the bottom lip you’re biting and make a scary face.*
