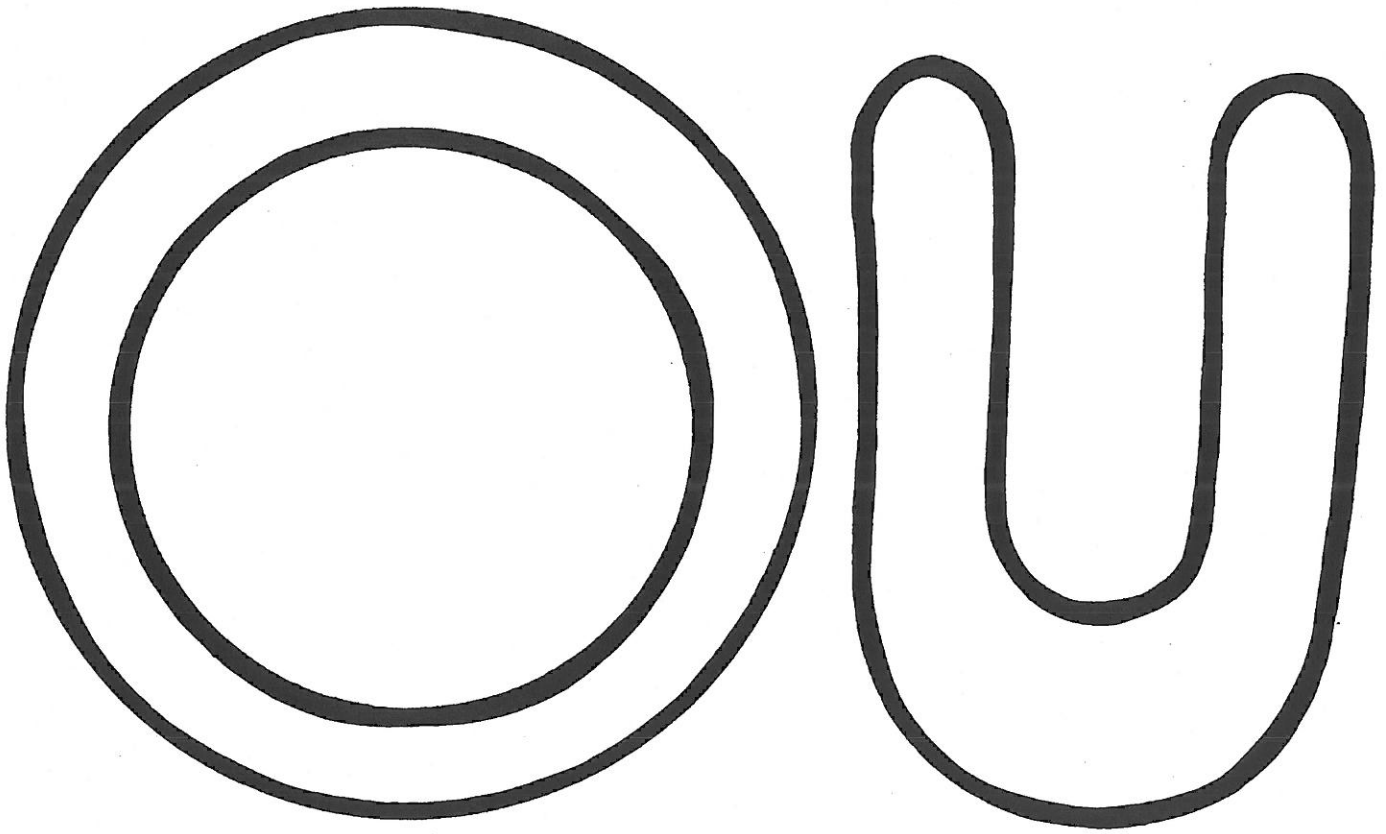
The Baby and the Toddler

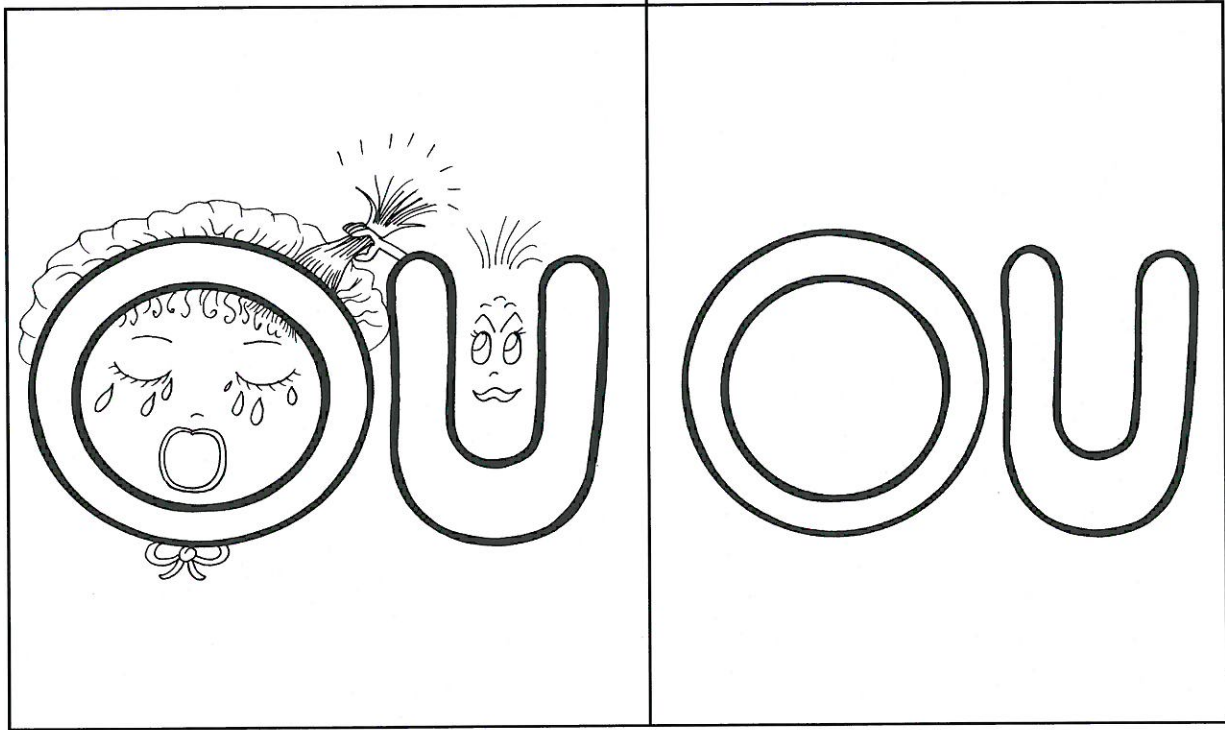
Hand cue: Pull a few strands of your hair and make a face as if it hurts.

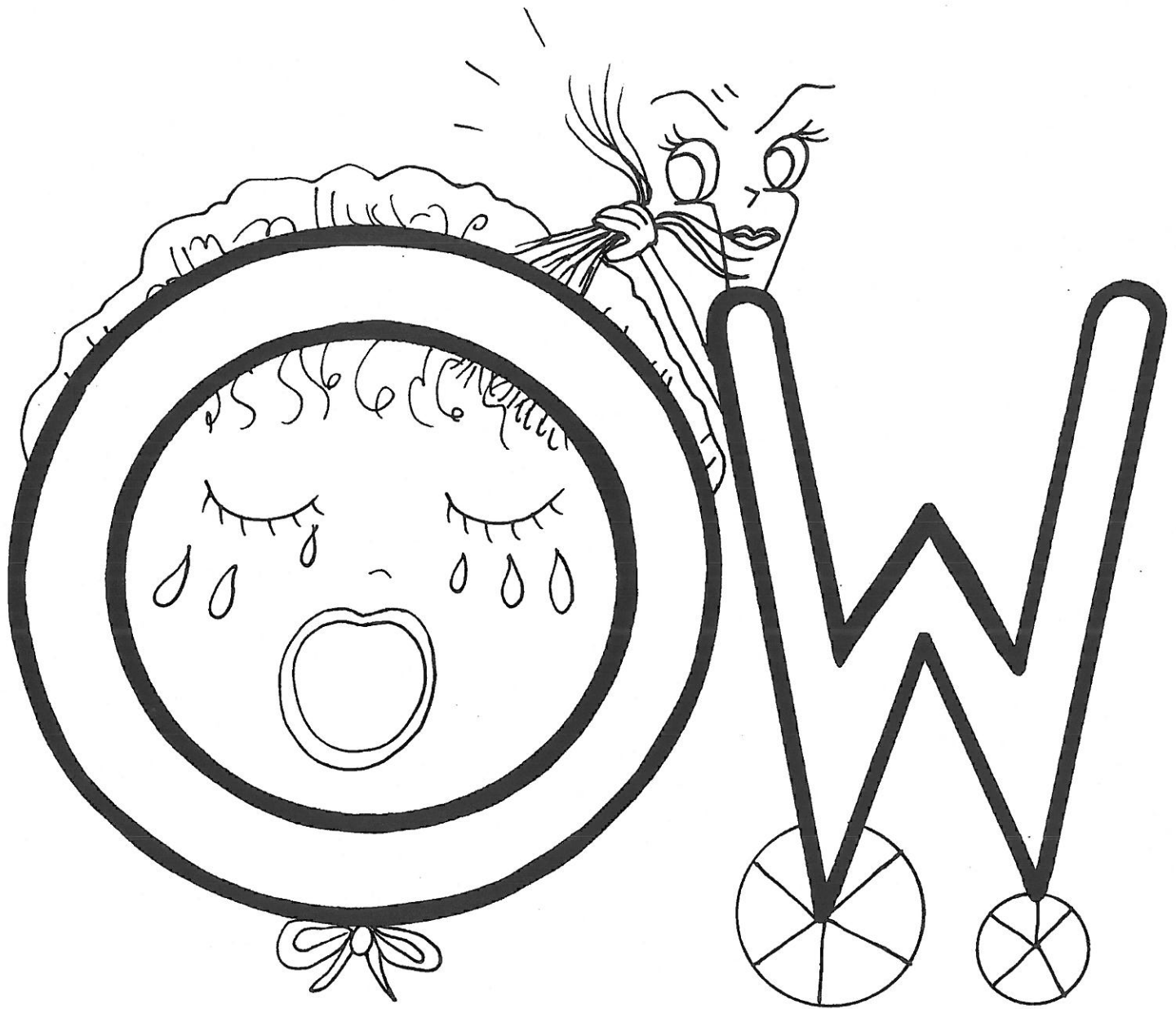

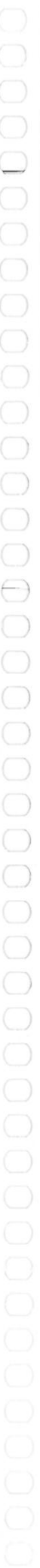


The Baby and the Wheelchair

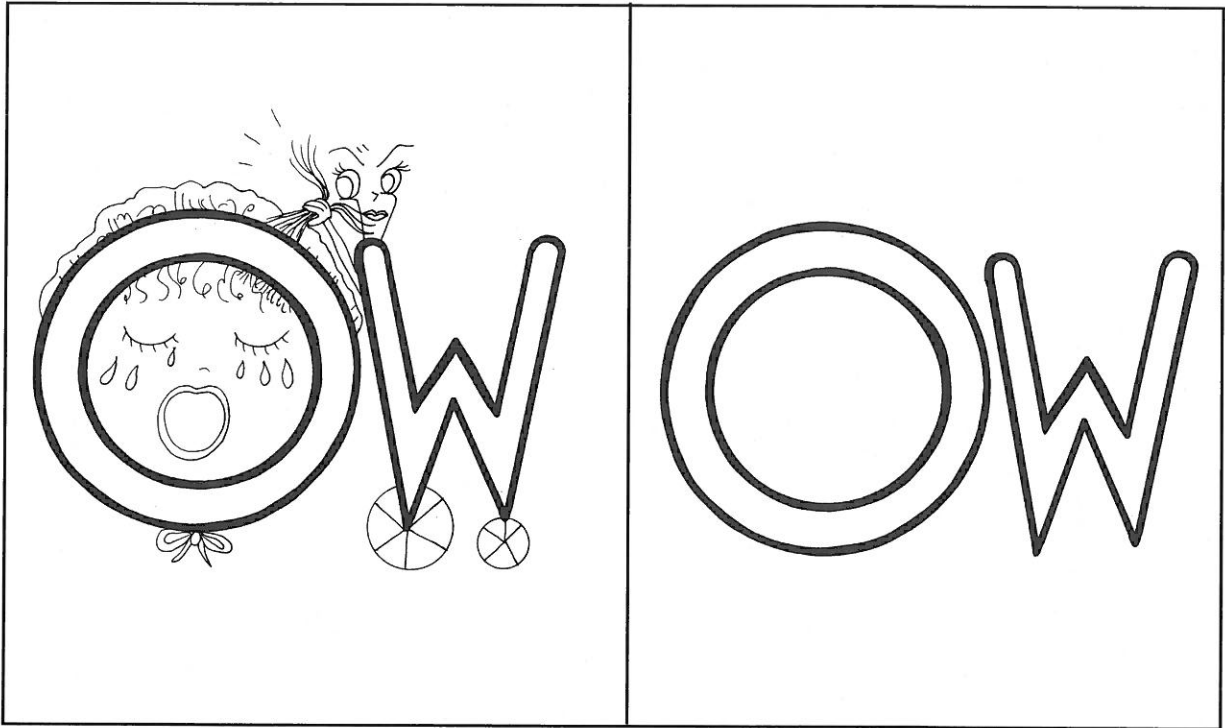
Story – The wheelchair (who is double trouble when a vowel gets before him) pulls the baby’s hair when she is in front of him. The baby says, “Ow!”
